Paraty is one of the few places in the world where you can find so many natural beauties such as forests, ocean, waterfalls and beaches. Especially the bay of Paraty, which is one of the most pleasant areas of the Brazilian coast: perfect for sailing, diving or just relaxing on the beach.



Paraty

Day 1: Arrival in Paraty

Tour in the historical city center of Paraty during the day:

Walking tour (Duration: 1h 30min)

A journey back in time through the cobblestone streets of the city, with its historic and uniquely beautiful buildings. Masonry, pirates, gold, coffee and sugar cane cycles, towns and economic cycles that mark the history of Paraty. A world of information, and you will see Paraty with different eyes. You will probably have the opportunity to visit the workshop of the resident potter at the Sandi Hotel and perhaps have a production of your own clay piece.

Day 2: Paraty

Breakfast at the hotel.

Private Yatch Ride in the region with visit to desert beaches, amazing islands and a Marine Farm (Duration: 08 hours)

The Paraty Bay offers a safe and quiet navigation, we are a super sheltered place and we have 65 islands and more than 300 excellent beaches for swimming and snorkeling. Guests can choose one of several restaurants to enjoy a gastronomic experience by the sea. It is a 8-hour tour with the most incredible places of Paraty Bay, on the Motorboat Highway as in the photo. Travel tip: In this boat ride, we will discover the Saco do Mamanguá, known as a tropical fjord. The place was the setting for the filming of the movie Twilight - Breaking Dawn, and was chosen for the honeymoon of the characters Edward (Robert Pattinson) and Bella (Kristen Stewart), for being an intimate region with a paradisiacal landscape. Visit to "Coquille da Cajaíba", the marine farm, located in Pouso da Cajaíba, works on the cultivation of scallops and mussels involving sustainable management and partnership with a caiçara family, encouraging the local economy and preserving the traditional knowledge of the region.

Dinner at Pupu's restaurant

At this restaurant, chef Bernardo Artuso prepares his creative version of Japanese cuisine and shares his Asian fusion cuisine at Pupu's Peixe Panc. As the name suggests, the trend is to combine seafood (and local fish) with edible plants and flowers, the pancs. The result is dishes as tasty as they are colorful and photogenic.

Day 3 - Paraty

Breakfast at hotel.

Gastromare (Duration: 06 hours)

On board the "Sem Pressa" boat, a 50-foot trawler, designed and custom-built by local artisans in Paraty, all in reforested wood, enjoy nautical catering of high Brazilian cuisine, where the kitchen is the stage for recipes with local, seasonal ingredients and seafood coming straight from the fisherman, without middlemen, without preservatives. A comfortable structure, sofas, rooftop, toilet, shower and SUP (StandUp Paddle) available.

Gastromar was founded in 2014 by chef Gisela Schmitt and Lauretta da Martinica from experiences with friends and contact with the sea.

Day 4 - Paraty

Breakfast at the Hotel.

Mata Atlantica Tour with Visit at Bananal Farm with local experience and lunch (Duration: 08 hours)

The Bananal Farm in Paraty is ideal for families, with activities in harmony with nature.

On this tour, visitors have the opportunity to experience a true immersion in the Atlantic Forest and connect with Paraty's biodiversity and culture.

As well as making incredible discoveries about the diversity of life in the forest, it's a fantastic way to strengthen admiration and respect for nature.

Below is a summary of the attractions included in Bananal Farm Experiences:

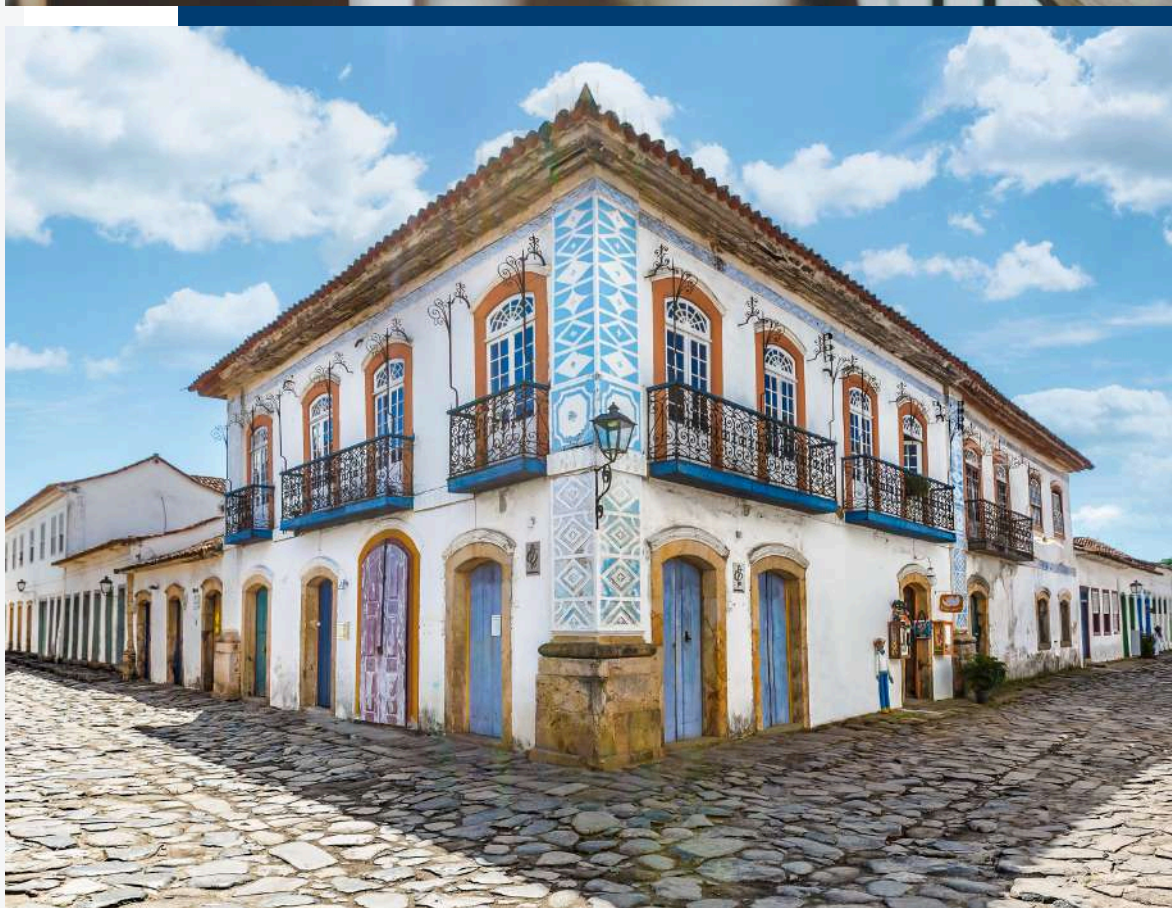
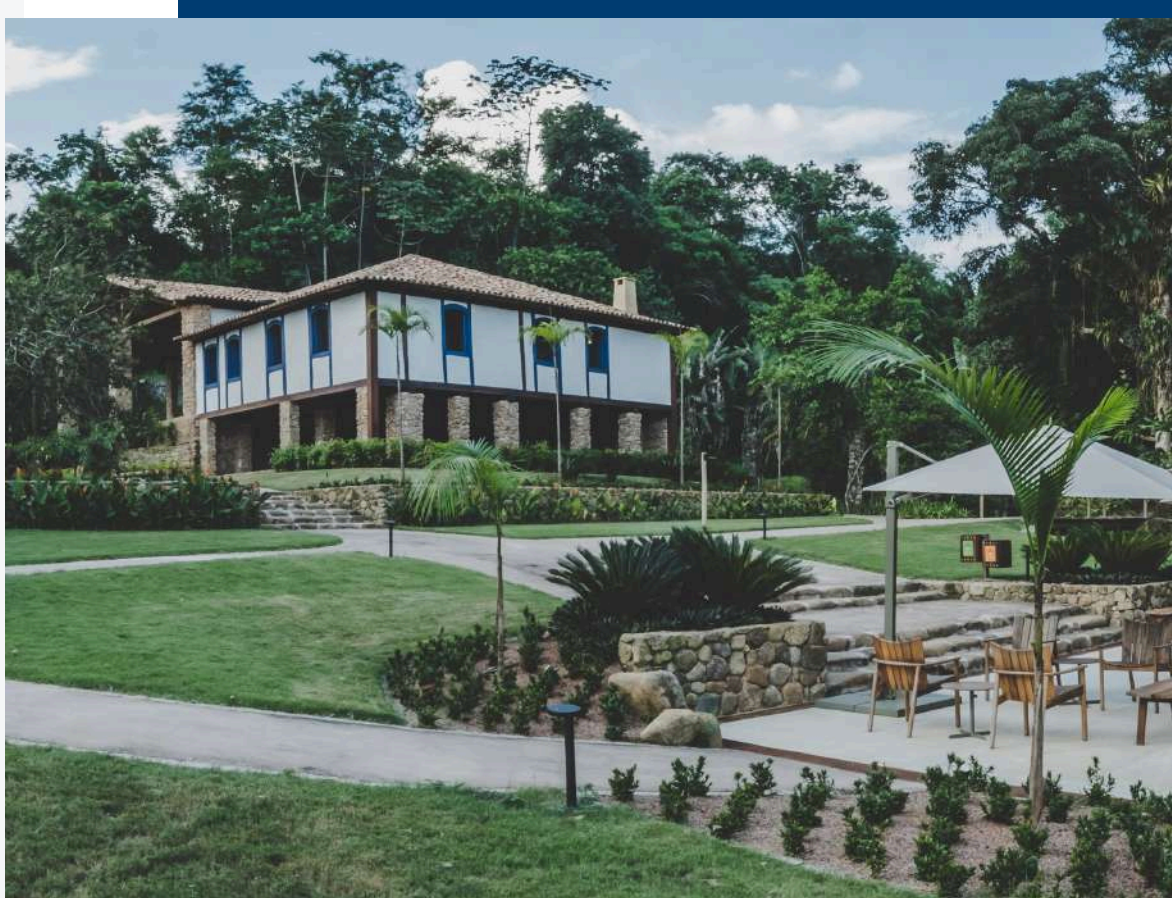
- Workshops at the Sustainable House: Activities using sustainable materials that will make your day even more fun.
- Sustainable Technology Models: In this experience, visitors discover how, using the power and intelligence of nature, we can create cleaner and more sustainable production systems, such as organic gardens, agroforestry, biodigesters, solar ovens and more.
- A Night in the Forest exhibition: Here there is an interactive simulation of the night forest in broad daylight, provoking magical curiosities about biodiversity. And with interactive and educational elements, they promote the construction of knowledge in a fun way.
- Naturalized Park: With toys made of wood, the park enables the experience of free play and imagination, in a playful composition with nature and natural resources such as logs, branches, stones, seeds, water, earth and others.
- Forest Path: An accessible walkway to experience the preserved Atlantic Forest, with an exhibition on the Forest Floors that tells the story of the local forest, biodiversity and the history of the people who have lived and passed through Paraty.
- Historical Building: A building listed by IPHAN as a Historical Heritage Site, it retains its original structure and is now the venue for an exhibition in partnership with the Casa da Cultura de Paraty: Paraty em meio a Mata, which draws a parallel between Paraty's biodiversity and culture, with pieces made by local artists/craftspeople.
- Bananal fair: In the store you can find products grown and produced on the Fazenda, as well as local handicrafts from different areas of the country.
- Gastronomy: Bananal has a restaurant and a café with super-fresh products prepared by a chef specializing in forest-to-table cuisine.

Day 5 - Paraty - Departure

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out.





Loft Bom jardim

This is an exclusive house in Paraty Bay, with 1 master suite and 02 suites. Suspended over the ocean, the old boathouse, which served as a support, was redesigned to become a modern and airy loft, with walls and glass that reveal an incredible view of the Bay of Paraty and the Atlantic Rain Florest.

In the surroundings there is a beach with 200 meters of sand strip, coconut trees, palm trees, vegetable garden, organic vegetable garden with spices and a private and catalogued botanical garden, with more than 5 thousand jussara, lychee and passion fruit trees.





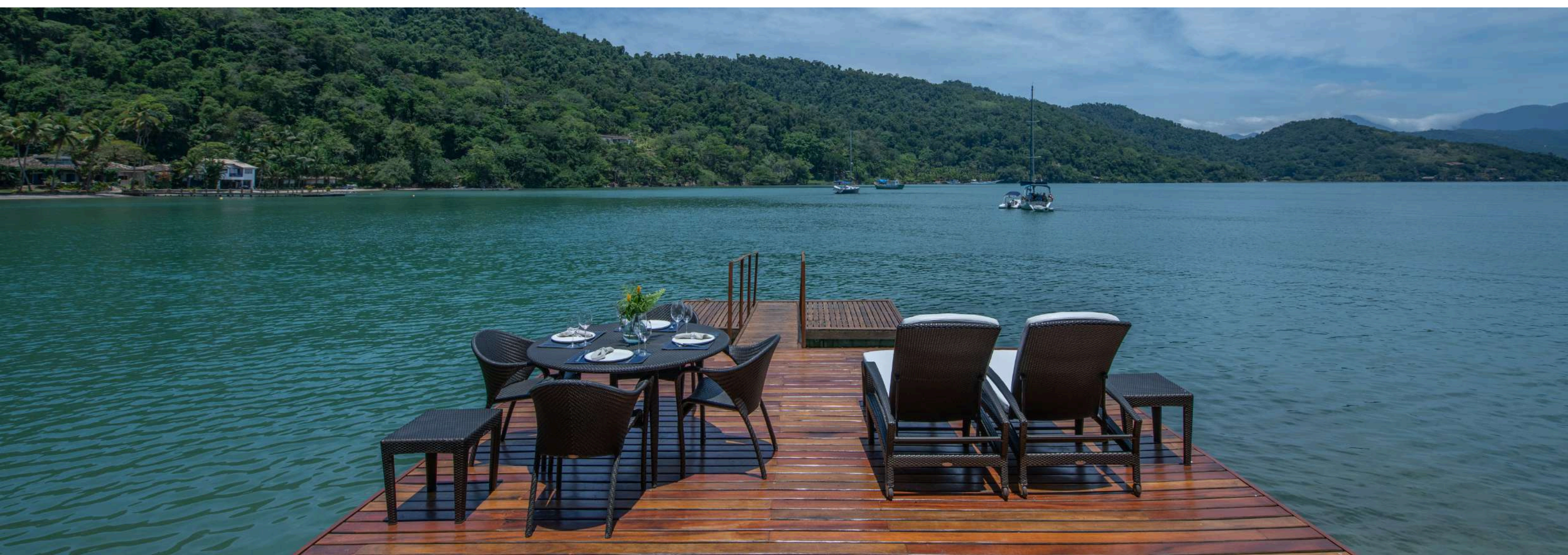
There, visitors can walk two trails, one through the botanical garden, behind the main house, with native plants of the Atlantic Forest, palms and fruit trees.

The second trail leads to the Forte da Tapera, also within the property, with three cannons from the time of the Brazilian Colony pointing towards the sea. This fort protected against the invasion of Dutch and English pirates. From the top, the place offers a privileged view of the Bay of Paraty, from where you can see, in the distance, the Historic Center, the Capelinha and the Igreja da Matriz.

Villa Bom jardim

A delightful seaside property located 15 minutes by boat from Paraty's ports. With a private garden of 30.000m2. An Exclusive Villa with 7 Suites, living Room, dining Room, TV Room, Varanda Gourmet Area, 2 Kitchens, Gym, Sauna and 3 Rooms for Staff. The house with the most classical colonial style in Paraty was totally recast on 2020 with a project from renowned Architect Marcos Tomanik. The floors were changed for a beautiful Spanish tile. Decorative pieces purchased by the family for more than 50 years in nautical antique sales embellish the house, such as an original navy compass, aqualung and imitation of english sailing boats, combined with navy colors and tropical themes.



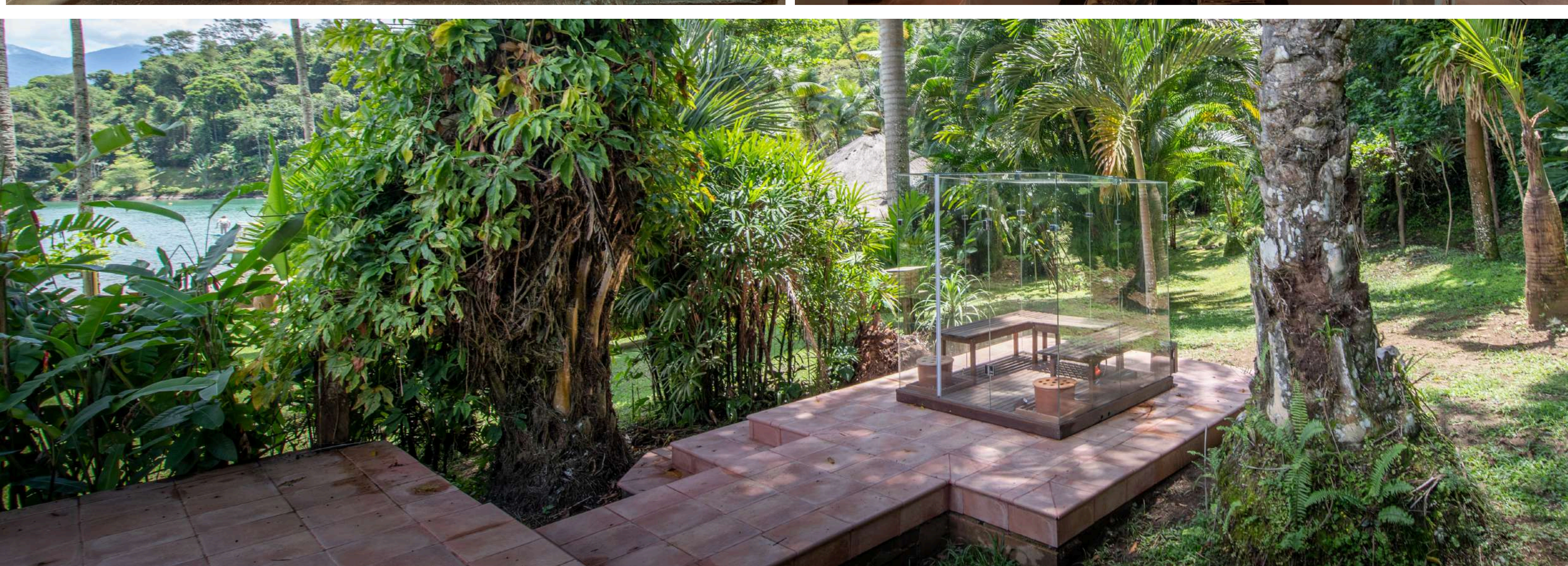

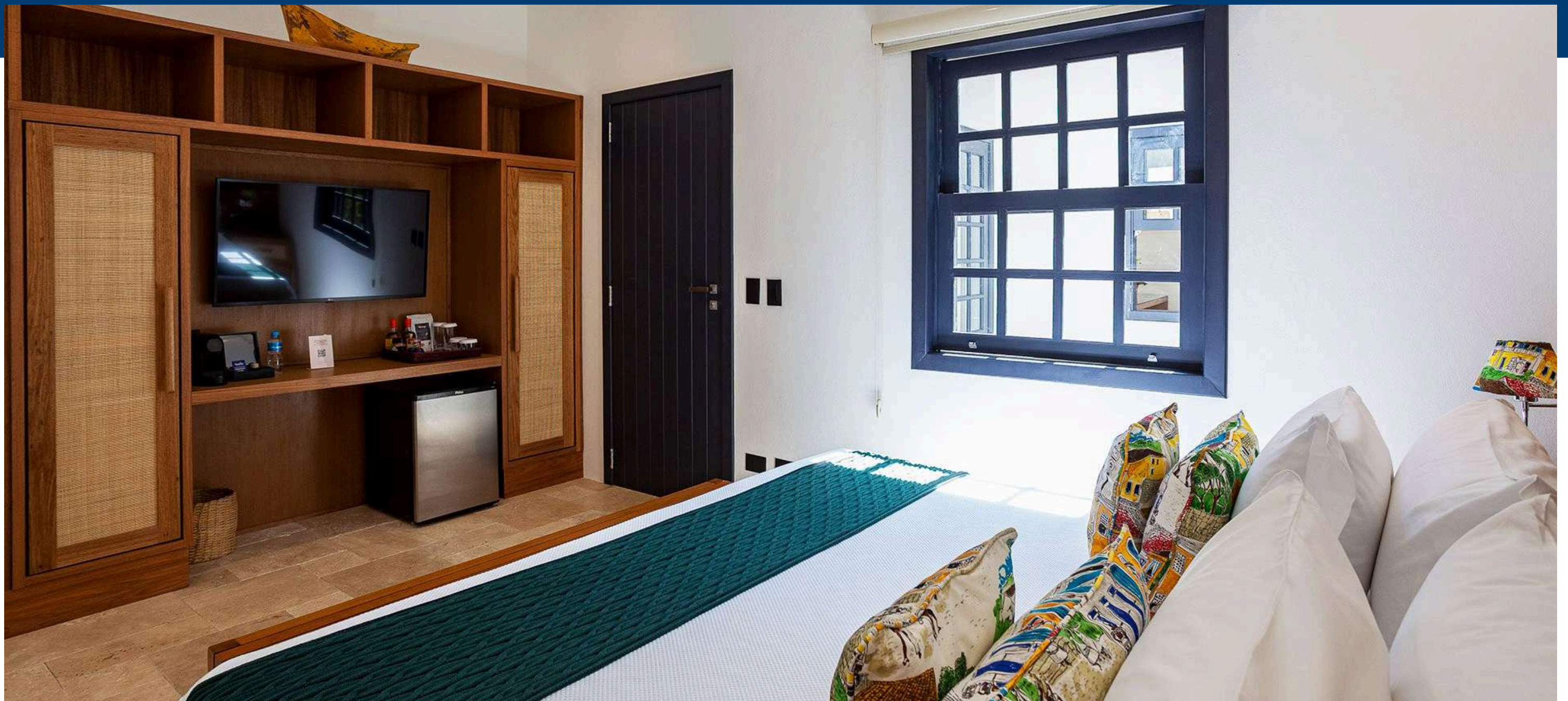




Sandi Hotel

Located in the heart of the Historic Center of Paraty. Built in the 18th century, the hotel was once a school group and a social club. Today Sandi Hotel is considered a postcard of the city, preserving the architecture of the Colonial era.

The Sandi Hotel has a beautiful collection of paintings, works of art, books and many other special objects, collected over the years by Sandra Foz and Sandi Adamiu.

Guests can discover original pieces by Carmen, paintings by Gabriel Wickbold and Aécio Sarti and art by Márcio Franco. There are also photographs by Italian Giancarlo Mecarelli, paintings by Croatian Renato Loledic and works by George Gondor and Nadaletto. The exhibition and gallery of lithographs "das Coisas Naturais do Brasil" aims to divulge and celebrate Brazilian nature and its heroes.

Also present in the hotel is the collection of objects related to the audiovisual industry and personal objects collected by the family over 3 generations of icons such as Marlon Brandon, Alfred Hitchcock, Ingrid Bergman and Rita Hayworth.

It also highlights the letter from President Jânio Quadros to Alexandre Adamiu during his stay at the hotel. Finally, two unique books, a tribute to Muhammad Ali and memories of the legend Ayrton Senna.
